


Figure 1 Switching Test Circuit






Figure 2 Switching Waveform




T_J-Junction Temperature (°C)

Figure 3 Power Dissipation





Figure 4 Drain Current









V_{ds} Drain-Source Voltage (V)




Figure 13 Safe Operation Area





Figure 14 Normalized Maximum Transient Thermal Impedance
